## **Abbey Atwater**

Clarinetist **Abbey Atwater** began her musical studies at age eleven. Abbey has had numerous musical accomplishments, including a performance of Carl Maria von Weber's *Concertino* with the Waukesha Area Symphonic Band in May 2015. She has also received an honorable mention in the Oshkosh Symphony Young Artists Competition in 2016, was runner-up in the Music Teachers National Association Young Artists Competition the same year, and was a finalist in the Lawrence University Symphony Orchestra Concerto Competition in 2017 and 2018. In the summer of 2016, Abbey attended the Pacific Region International Summer Music Academy in British Columbia. Abbey has held principal and E-flat clarinet positions in Lawrence University's Wind Ensemble and Orchestra and served as co-principal of the Waukesha Area Chamber Orchestra from 2012-2017. She is highly active in various chamber ensembles including a wind trio, reed quintet, and new music ensemble. Additionally, Abbey has performed in master classes for renowned artists such as Julian Bliss, David Shifrin, and Imani Winds. She is currently completing her fourth year of undergraduate studies at Lawrence University, pursuing a B.M. in clarinet performance under the instruction of David Bell. This fall, Abbey will begin her M.M. in clarinet performance at Temple University where she will study with Paul Demers, bass clarinetist of the Philadelphia Orchestra. She would like to thoroughly thank Professor Bell as well as her friends and family for all the advice and support they have offered with her musical ambitions.
